In feed, most protein comes from soybean, canola or sunflower meal, a byproduct made when these plants are processed for oil. Protein in chicken feed can also come from lupins or peas or even from animal byproducts such as bone, feather and fish meal. In some cases, even poultry meat and feather by-meal are used in chicken feed. Nature's Best Organic Feeds have zero animal byproducts.</p> <p>Fat: In chicken feed, fats or oils are added.
